## Guided tours for newcomers.

Newcomers to the Basel region will be offered tours of the city featuring valuable tips on everyday life in Basel.

Tips will be provided on shopping, cultural facilities and leisure programmes, as well as introductions to essential themes such as transport, postal and health services.

The start of the tour leads past the Tourist Information at the Swiss Railway Station SBB, a centrally located point to be contacted for cultural and leisure planning in Basel and the region. Further stations of the tour include the Old Town and of course the seat of the government of the Canton of Basel-Stadt, the City Hall or Rathaus.

The tour lasts two and a half hours. This offer is a joint project organised by the Department of Presidential Affairs of the Canton of Basel-Stadt and Basel Tourism.
